

## Presidential Disaster Declaration

President Trump approved Harrison County as a major disaster area. The declaration makes assistance available to homeowners, renters, businesses, public entities and select nonprofit organizations.

Federal **Individual Assistance** is available for Harrison County. Residents are encouraged to apply, regardless of their income. Individuals and business owners who sustained losses in the designated area can begin applying for assistance by registering online at [www.DisasterAssistance.gov](http://www.DisasterAssistance.gov) or by calling 1-800-621- 3362 or 1-800-462-7585 TTY. The toll-free telephone numbers will operate from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. (local time), seven days a week, until further notice.

Iowa Individual Disaster Assistance is available for families whose household annual income is 200% or less of the federal poverty level. Qualifying household may receive up to \$5,000.
