

CITY COUNCIL MEETING

DECEMBER 20, 2016
6:00 P.M.

Mayor Sargent presided over the regular session and called it to order at 6:00 p.m. with the following Council members present: Johnson, Gunderson, Struble. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Moved by Council member Struble to approve the Agenda for December 20, 2016, seconded by Council member Johnson. Motion carried on a 3-0 vote.

Moved by Council member Struble to approve the Consent Agenda, seconded by Council member Gunderson. Motion carried on a 3-0 vote.

Minnie Fisher addressed Council and asked for their help in alleviating a parking issue on Erie Street.

(Council member Thompson arrived).

Lee Wisecup asked if Newton ditch north of the sewer lagoons could be cleaned out. This will be looked into.

The City presented its' response to the police union's initial proposal. There was no representative present to accept on their behalf.

City Clerk/Administrator Miller informed Council that Olmsted and Perry Consulting Engineering is still in the process of gathering information on the drainage tube at Canal/Hwy 30. Once that is completed, Council will be advised.

City Clerk/Administrator Miller reported the City has received the inspection report from DNR on the wastewater system. City will need to provide a plan on addressing the I/I concerns.
