

SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING

JANUARY 26, 2016
5:00 P.M.

Mayor Sargent presided over the special session and called it to order at 5:00 p.m. with the following Council members present: Thompson, Struble, Tiffey, Gunderson. Council member Johnson was absent. Also present were City Clerk/Administrator Miller and visitor Jesusa Christians.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Moved by Council member Struble to approve the Agenda, seconded by Council member Tiffey. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote.

Miller explained options for property at 105 W Superior. Following discussion, moved by Council member Thompson to start abandonment proceedings on the property and then apply for a demo grant thru SWIPCO, seconded by Council member Tiffey. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote.

Moved by Council member Struble to accept the proposal from Sherman Co. for the starters on the backwash pumps, seconded by Council member Gunderson. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote.

Miller explained proposal for the white signage area on the caboose. Moved by Council member Tiffey to approve "Welcome to Missouri Valley – a Train Town USA", seconded by Council member Thompson. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote.

Miller was directed to refer the invoice from Feld Fire regarding the sirens to the City Attorney.

Council reviewed information for the FY17 budget and directed Miller how to proceed.

Mayor set a Budget Workshop for February 9, 2016 at 5:00 p.m. at the City Hall.

Moved to adjourn by Council member Struble, seconded by Council member Tiffey. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote. Meeting adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
