Mayor Sargent opened the Public Hearing to consider a lease with the Harrison County Fair – Discussion was held on maintenance, term of lease and liability. Mayor Sargent closed the hearing at 6:07 p.m.

Mayor Sargent presided over the regular session and called it to order with the following Council members present: Struble, Tiffey, Gunderson and Thompson. Council member Johnson was absent. Also present were City Clerk/Administrator Miller and visitors: Leonard Ratliff, Bruce Kocher, Jesusa Christians.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Moved by Council member Tiffey to approve the Agenda as presented, seconded by Council member Struble. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote.

Moved by Council member Struble to approve the Consent Agenda, seconded by Council member Thompson. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote.

Library Director Kocher presented the activities at the Library in February.

Moved by Council member Struble to have the City Attorney draft a lease with the Harrison County Fair for Nissen Field including the land on the west side of Willow Road, seconded by Council member Thompson. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote.

Moved by Council member Thompson to approve the Fair Board's request for fireworks on July 29, 2017, seconded by Council member Struble. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote.

Moved by Council member Tiffey to approve the 1st reading of Ordinance #525, "An Ordinance Amending The Code Of Ordinances Of The City Of Missouri Valley, Iowa By Amending Provisions Pertaining To Dog License Fees", seconded by Council member Struble. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote.

Moved by Council member Struble to approve Resolution 17-06, "Resolution Setting The Per Diem Cost For Dog Impoundment", seconded by Council member Tiffey. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote.

Moved by Council member Struble to approve the request from Kiwanis/YEA for a pool pass donation for their annual fundraiser, seconded by Council member Thompson. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote.

Moved by Council member Tiffey to sell excess property (1989 F800 fire truck) at the Tekamah auction, seconded by Council member Struble. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote. A reserve was set at \$2,000.

Moved by Council member Struble to accept Mayor's recommendation of Sally Salter to fill the vacant position on the Park Board, seconded by Council member Thompson. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote.

Moved by Council member Struble to approve the request from AYSO to hang a banner on the pool fence, seconded by Council member Thompson. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote.

Moved by Council member Tiffey to approve the lease with Verizon Wireless for a small cell site, seconded by Council member Thompson. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote.

City Clerk/Administrator Miller gave an update from USACE on the Sect 205 study. They expect the study to be completed the end of September, a public meeting in November and wrap up/approvals in January 2018.

Moved to adjourn by Council member Struble, seconded by Council member Tiffey. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote. Meeting adjourned at 6:35 p.m.

ORDINANCE #525

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MISSOURI VALLEY, IOWA BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO DOG LICENSE FEES

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Missouri Valley, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED. Section 56.02 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Missouri Valley, Iowa is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

56.02 LICENSE FEES. The annual license fee shall be \$10.00 for altered dogs and \$15.00 for unaltered dogs.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
