

CITY COUNCIL WORKSHOP
CITY HALL CONFERENCE ROOM
MAY 2, 2017
5:00 P.M.

Mayor Sargent presided over the workshop and called it to order at 5:00 p.m. with the following Council members present: Struble, Gunderson, Johnson and Thompson. Also present were CC/A Miller and City Engineer Olmsted.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Moved by Council member Thompson, seconded by Council member Struble to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote.

Council discussed water and sewer line extensions to the east of town, estimated costs, and payment options. Mr. Olmsted explained the concept of ‘pioneering’ utility lines as a means for a developer to get a project completed sooner and be able to recoup some costs.

Following discussion, moved by Council member Thompson, seconded by Council member Struble, to authorize the creation of a pioneering policy. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote.

Council was reminded of the need to annex the area prior to constructing the water and sewer lines. They will be contacting property owners with the goal of having everyone contacted within 30 days.

Moved to adjourn by Struble, seconded by Johnson. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote. Meeting adjourned at 5:50 p.m.
