

CITY COUNCIL MEETING
RAND CENTER
MAY 3, 2016
6:00 P.M.

Mayor Sargent opened the Public Hearing on the alley reconstruction project and asked for comments. There were none and he closed the hearing.

Mayor Sargent presided over the meeting and called it to order at 6:00 p.m. with the following Council members present: Thompson, Gunderson, Johnson, Struble. Council member Tiffey was absent. Also present were City Clerk/Administrator Miller, Jim Olmsted, Greg Perry, Chief Murray and visitors: Adam Bellis, Dave Scott, John Riley, Michael Rossbund, Leonard Ratliff, Jesusa Christians.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Moved by Council member Johnson to approve the Agenda for May 3, 2016, seconded by Council member Struble. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote.

Moved by Council member Struble to approve the Consent Agenda with the additional CenturyLink bills, seconded by Council member Thompson. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote.

Mayor Sargent opened and read the bids on the 2016 Alley Pavement Reconstruction Project. He gave them to Olmsted & Perry for review and recommendation.

Dave Scott addressed the Council in regard to the proposed new fire station project.

Council discussed traffic control in the alley north of the Rand Center. Moved by Council member Thompson to pursue a stop sign in the alley for eastbound traffic at the 4th Street intersection, seconded by Council member Johnson. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote. City Clerk/Administrator will prepare an Ordinance for the next meeting.

Moved by Council member Johnson to eliminate the Public Works Director position and revert Bob Riesland to Street Superintendent, seconded by Council member Thompson. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote.

Moved by Council member Struble to approve Resolution 16-12, "Resolution Setting Wages (Seasonal)", seconded by Council member Johnson. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote.

Olmsted reported to Council the apparent low bid on the alley reconstruction project is Spring Lake Construction. The Council will review their credentials because they haven't worked with the City previously and will award the bid at the next meeting.

City Clerk/Administrator informed Council she has completed her annual training in Continuing Disclosure and reviewed the requirements with Council.

Moved to adjourn by Council member Struble, seconded by Council member Johnson. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote. Meeting adjourned at 6:38 p.m.
