SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING

6:00 P.M.**

Mayor Kelly presided over the meeting and called it to order at 6:00 P.M. with the following Council members present: Gunderson, Pfouts, Struble, Stueve, and Tiffey. Also present: Tonia Copeland, Vonda Ford.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Kelly asked Council for any comments or additions. There were none.

Motion by Struble, seconded by Tiffey to approve the agenda for the June 3, 2019 meeting. Motion carried on a 5-0 vote.

There were no comments from citizens.

Motion by Struble, seconded by Tiffey to enter into closed session at 6:01p.m. per IA Code 21.5(1)(i) to evaluate the professional competency of an individual whose appointment, hiring, performance, or discharge is being considered when necessary to prevent needless and irreparable injury to that individual's reputation. Motion carried on a 5-0 vote.

Motion by Pfouts, seconded by Stueve to return to open session at 6:59P.M.with no action taken. Motion carried on a 5-0 vote.

Ford explained policy of WSI lifeguards giving private lessons and turning over funds to City with a 60% instructor/40% City split. The minutes from the 2012 meeting where it was put in place was handed out. Several reasons were stated why policy was put into place. An employee at the pool does not think it is fair. They had requested to be put on the June 18 agenda.
