

SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING  
MISSOURI VALLEY LIBRARY – COMMUNITY ROOM  
JULY 29, 2017  
11:30 A.M.

Mayor Sargent presided over the workshop and called it to order at 11:38 a.m. with the following Council members present: Struble, Gunderson, Johnson and Thompson. Council member Tiffey was absent. Also present were CC/A Miller, Congressman King and Bill Anderson.

Moved by Council member Thompson to approve the agenda, seconded by Council member Struble. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote.

Mayor Sargent gave a background of the City's flood mitigation efforts, including the Tri-County Willow Creek Watershed and US Army Corps of Engineers partnerships. Discussion followed between Congressman King, Mayor, and Council on the need for the Hwy 30 by-pass. King expressed support and will follow up with a letter to IDOT and USACE asking them to come up with a consensus on a plan for this project.

CC/A Miller addressed the Council with update on the cemetery road. After removing the asphalt, the top section of concrete looked good so only the first 200' will be replaced. That will enable the crew to repair a section of the 4<sup>th</sup> Street entrance as well. Council was in agreement.

Moved to adjourn by Council member Johnson, seconded by Council member Struble. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote. Meeting adjourned at 12:37 p.m.
