

SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING

Mayor Pro-Tem Struble presided over the meeting and called it to order at 6:00 P.M. with the following Council members present: Gunderson, Pfouts, Struble, and Stueve Absent: Tiffey. Also present were: Brenda Osborn and Ed Murray.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Struble asked Council for any comments or additions-None.

Motion by Gunderson, seconded by Stueve to approve the agenda for the August 28, 2018 meeting.
Motion carried on a 4-0 vote.

Brenda Osborn spoke to the Council about the continuing bat issues at City Hall. An exterminator was called and he found multiple carcasses on Monday. The carcasses created an extreme fly issue. Osborn is concerned about employee health and detrimental working conditions. Flaherty reached out to the contractor after the quote was approved by Council. He will be coming within the next couple of weeks. Flaherty will contact him and see if she can get a defined timeline.

Motion by Pfouts, seconded by Stueve to approve and submit the language for the Library Board of Trustees Ordinance for the November election ballot. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote.
