

CITY COUNCIL WORKSHOP

SEPTEMBER 7, 2017
7:00 P.M.

Mayor Sargent presided over the meeting and called it to order at 7:00 p.m. with the following Council members present: Struble, Thompson, Johnson, Gunderson. Council member Tiffey was absent. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Moved by Council member Struble to approve the agenda, seconded by Council member Johnson. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote.

Mayor Sargent addressed Item #6 Consider Options To Ensure Continued/Uninterrupted Operations Of The City. Since Tuesday night there has been communication with John McCurdy (SWIPCO), City Attorney Argotsinger as well as other contacts that had to be made. At this time we are unable to appoint a designated bank signatory and unable to appointment an interim City Clerk. Therefore, I will be meeting on Friday, September 8th with John McCurdy as this is a lengthy process. Also the City Staff will be addressed on Friday. Regarding the Designated Bank Signatory there are two signatures required in which the Mayor is one and recommending at the next city council meeting Council member Struble be placed as the second designated bank signatory.

Mayor Sargent asked for a next meeting be scheduled for Monday, September 11th. Council discussed timeframes and agreed 10:00 a.m. at the Missouri Valley City Hall. The item to be addressed is appoint signatory.

Mayor Sargent recommends we work with SWIPCO on this process and utilize them. SWIPCO will be our search and recommendations for the position and bring forward names. The Mayor makes a recommendation and the Council picks the individual for the City Clerk position.

Council member Gunderson would like the salary of the City Clerk position be revisited and an independent party write the contract agreement for the position.

Mayor Sargent noted his concerns are insuring continuation of services and the City goes uninterrupted as much as possible thru this process.

Moved to adjourn by Council member Struble, seconded by Council member Thompson. Motion carried on a 4-0 vote. Meeting adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
