

Dog Park Rules

- The City of Missouri Valley and its agents, officers, and employees are not responsible for any damage or injury to any persons, animals, or property.
- Park users and dog owners assume all risks, and are legally and financially responsible for all their dogs' actions at the park.
- All park patrons must agree to comply with the dog park rules.
- All dogs must have current rabies vaccination and city license tags displayed on their collars. (Missouri Valley Codes 56.02 and 56.03) Current annual immunizations are strongly recommended.
- Dogs must be on a leash when entering and exiting the park. (Missouri Valley Code 55.06)
- Keep gates closed at all times.
- Pick up your dogs' waste immediately and dispose of it properly. (Missouri Valley Code 55.10) All areas inside and outside of the park must remain clear of dog waste, litter, and cigarette butts.
- STAY WITH YOUR DOG AND OBSERVE THEIR BEHAVIOR AT ALL TIMES.
- If you are asked to leave the park due to your dog's behavior, honor that request. Refusal to leave would be considered trespassing.
- Bring water for your dog. Water is not guaranteed by the city.
- If your dog inflicts any injury, offer assistance, give your name, address, phone number and tag numbers of your dog, to the other owner before leaving the park. State law requires any animal bites to be reported to law enforcement. (Code of Iowa Sec. 351.38 and Missouri Valley Code 55.11)
- PARK HOURS: Sunrise - Sunset

Not Permitted:

- Human food, dog food/treats
- Glass containers, alcohol of any type, smoking
- Non-altered male dogs, female dogs in heat
- Aggressive dogs, puppies under 4 months old
- Children under age 14, unless with an adult
