

**CITY OF MISSOURI VALLEY  
SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
CITY HALL CONFERENCE ROOM  
TUESDAY, JANUARY 25, 2022**

Mayor Pro-Tem Struble presided over the meeting and called it to order at 6:00 p.m. with the following Council members present: Ford, Struble, Stueve, and Tuttle. Absent: Kelly and Taylor. Also Present: Caleb Wohlers and Bruce Kocher.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

There were no Mayor or Council comments or additions.

Motion by Ford, seconded by Stueve to approve the agenda for January 25, 2022. Motion carried unanimously.

There were no inquiries from citizens.

Motion by Ford, seconded by Stueve to allow the Mayor to read a proclamation for Career and Technical Education Month. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Stueve, seconded by Tuttle for the City to be the Project Applicant for the CDBG-CV grant for 500 East Erie Street. Motion carried unanimously.

Discussion was held on the FY 22/23 Budget. Council would like Flaherty to look at when Dog License fees were last raised. Council reviewed the new cemetery position and possible positions for Full-time EMTs. Council would like to further discuss the EMT positions before deciding to proceed. Flaherty is looking at costs for tuckpointing City Hall/Fire Station. Council would like updated Street Reconstruction Estimates. Flaherty will look at lowering the RUT expenses.

Motion by Ford, seconded by Tuttle to set the public hearing for FY 22/23 Max Levy for February 15, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
